

## **Administrative Procedure 216**

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### **COMPUTER ASSISTED LEARNING**

#### **Background**

The Division supports the establishment and maintenance of Computer Assisted Learning.

#### **Procedures**

1. The Ministry of Education Core Curriculum requires that students take fifty (50) hours of computer literacy by the time they complete grade nine. This may be accomplished through computer literacy courses or by integrating computer literacy learning with other courses in the regular school program.
2. Up-to-date computer hardware and software at the school and Division level continues to be purchased and maintained as finances permit.
3. The feasibility of utilizing computer technology to enhance the delivery of school programs is to be reviewed regularly.
4. The feasibility of utilizing computer technology to enhance inter-school and Division communication is to be reviewed regularly.
