

STUDENT RELOCATION ASSISTANCE

Background

The Division will provide assistance to students who are residents in the Division, but reside in a community where an appropriate program is not offered.

Procedures

1. Assistance may take the form of:
 - 1.1 Room and board support in a community within the Division where an appropriate program is available;
 - 1.2 Transportation assistance from home community to school community;
 - 1.3 Distance learning courses.
2. In addition the Division will support students to attend school outside of the Division in the following instances only:
 - 2.1 In the following communities where an established relationship exists with a town outside the Division:
 - 2.1.1 The Far North and Fond-du-Lac and Black Lake;
 - 2.1.2 Uranium City and Fort McMurray;
 - 2.1.3 Brabant Lake and Stanley Mission;
 - 2.1.4 Jan Lake area and Creighton.
 - 2.2 Students from the Athabasca Region may, on the approval of the Director, be supported at high schools out of the Division when the family situation warrants it. Generally, expenditures of students attending schools out of the Division would not be approved beyond the costs associated with educating the student at La Ronge.
 - 2.3 On the approval of the Director as it relates to special needs programming.
 - 2.4 The communities of Sled Lake/Dore Lake have had longstanding family ties with Big River. Where immediate family members in Big River are willing to act as guardians, the Division will sponsor students from Sled Lake/Dore Lake to attend high school in Big River.
 - 2.5 The community of Weyakwin has had longstanding family ties with Prince Albert. Where immediate family members in Prince Albert are willing to act as guardians, the Division will sponsor students from Weyakwin to attend high school in Prince Albert.
3. Students receiving room and board support will be expected to be in regular attendance, complete required assignments and avoid involvement in illegal

activities. Failure to do these things may result in the withdrawal of support if the student is over twenty-one (21) years of age and withdrawal of support for one (1) semester if the student is under twenty-one (21) years of age.
